My identity exists out of two sides. My introvert and shy side. And the side that is myself.

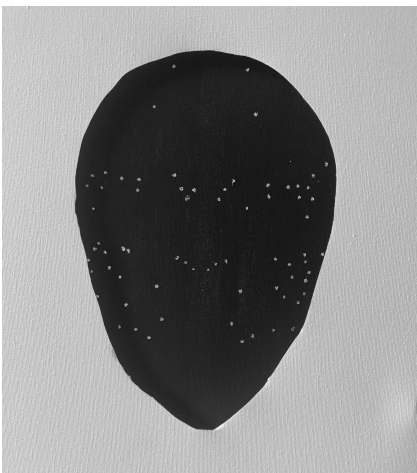

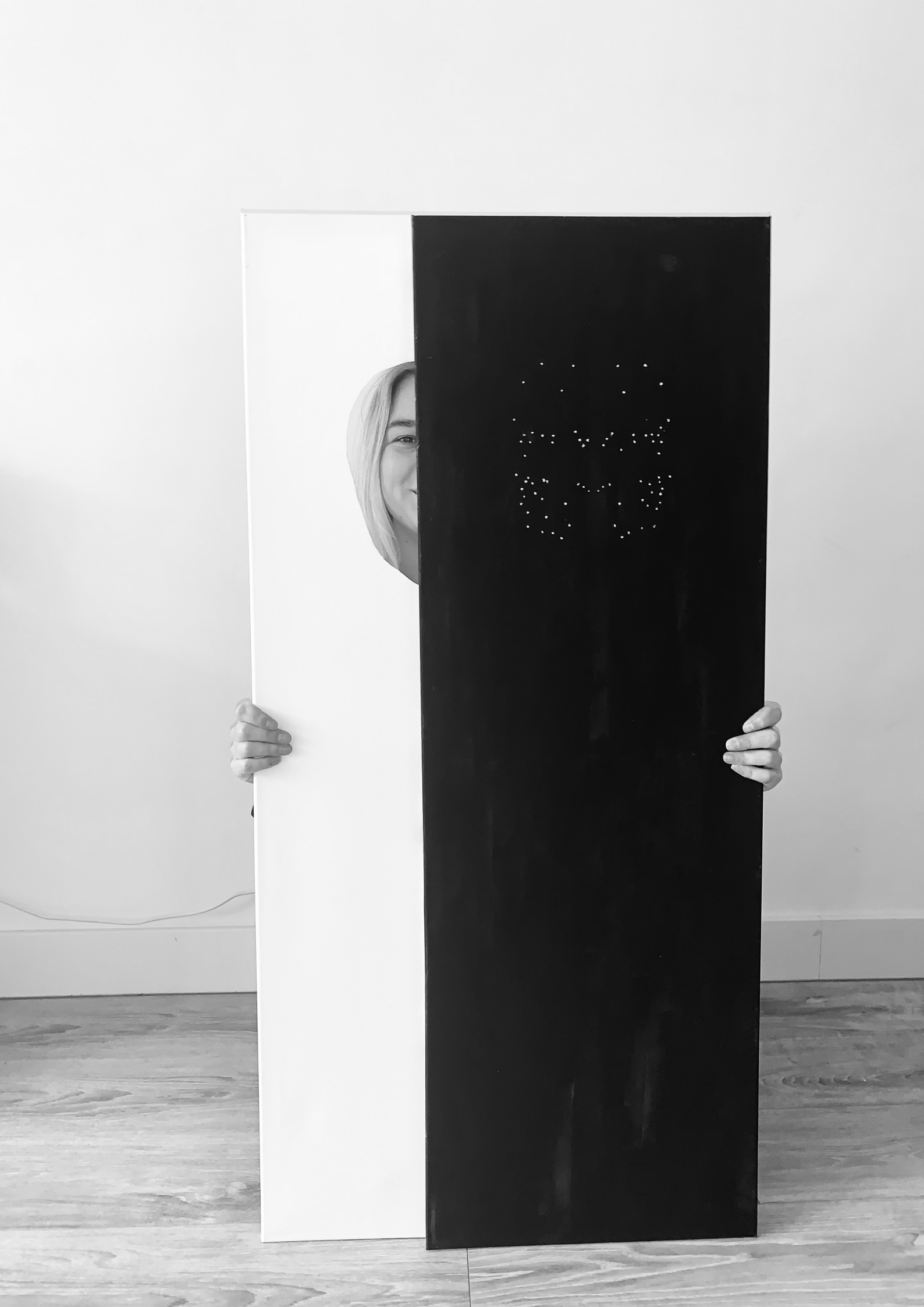
When I get comfortable I show my true self. The wall drops and I show me. Therefor I cut a the shape of my face. No need to hide.

With this mask I think the group I represent are introverts or showing your true self, insecurities. It can represent multiple things.

















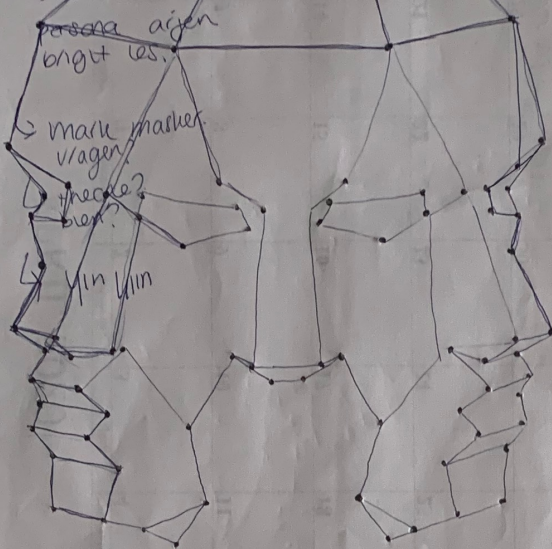






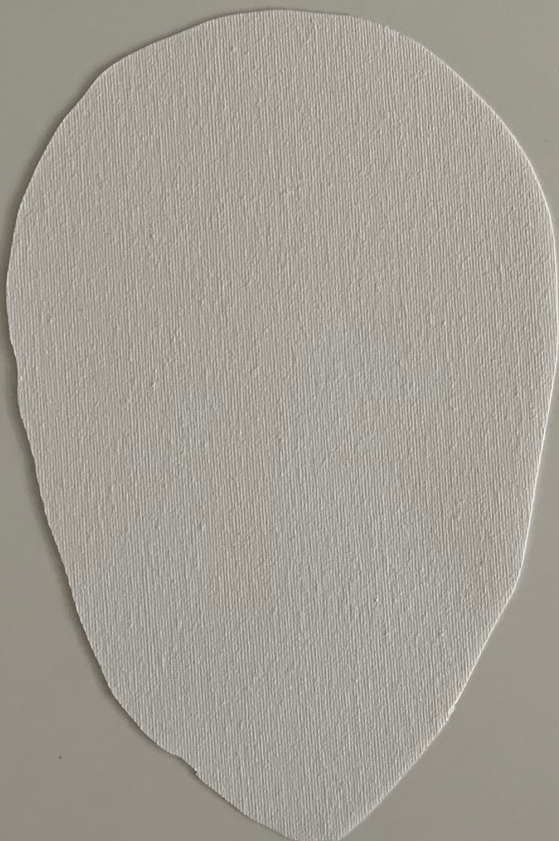
